Oikos University encourages a close and edifying relationship between faculty and students, one that will deepen the spiritual growth of each and stimulate a vigorous intellectual life in the University community. In order to accomplish these aims, it is imperative that Oikos University faculty, staff and students conduct themselves in a Christ-like and professional manner and maintain an exemplary and involved lifestyle. Regular church attendance and participation in the activities of the Oikos University community are encouraged for students and expected for faculty and staff.

Oikos University requires members of the University community—faculty, staff and students—to refrain from the illegal use of drugs and the abuse of addictive substances controlled by law.

Oikos University also forbids the use of alcohol, illicit drugs and tobacco on campus and prohibits the abuse of these substances by the Los Angeles community. The Apostle Paul exhorted the body of Christ that, if they truly loved their fellow man, they would set aside their personal freedom by refraining from behavior that might be a stumbling block to their weaker brother. Oikos University encourages members of the University community to exercise their personal responsibility and, guided by Paul's admonition, appropriately set aside their personal freedom and refrain from the use of alcohol, illicit drugs and tobacco.
